The **Elements** of Music

To learn about the music of the Symphony, its best to identify the fundamental elements of music which individually are quite simple. Below, we've listed these elements and provided a comprehensive definition of each.

Tempo is the speed at which music moves.

Melody is a line of notes that embody a collection of musical sentences.

Harmony is when you can hear two or more pitches at once.

Rhythm is the pattern of how notes are played or sung.

Pitch is how high or low a note can sound.

Dynamics are how loud or soft a note can sound.

Texture is the layering of different voices or instruments.

Timbre is a description of sound, usually referring to the instruments being played.

Form is the structure or organization of musical sections, which helps give the listener a sense of direction.
