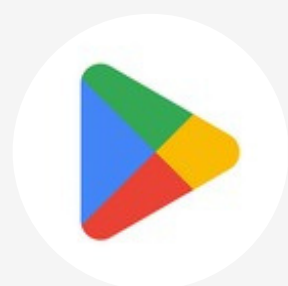


VicNet Guide



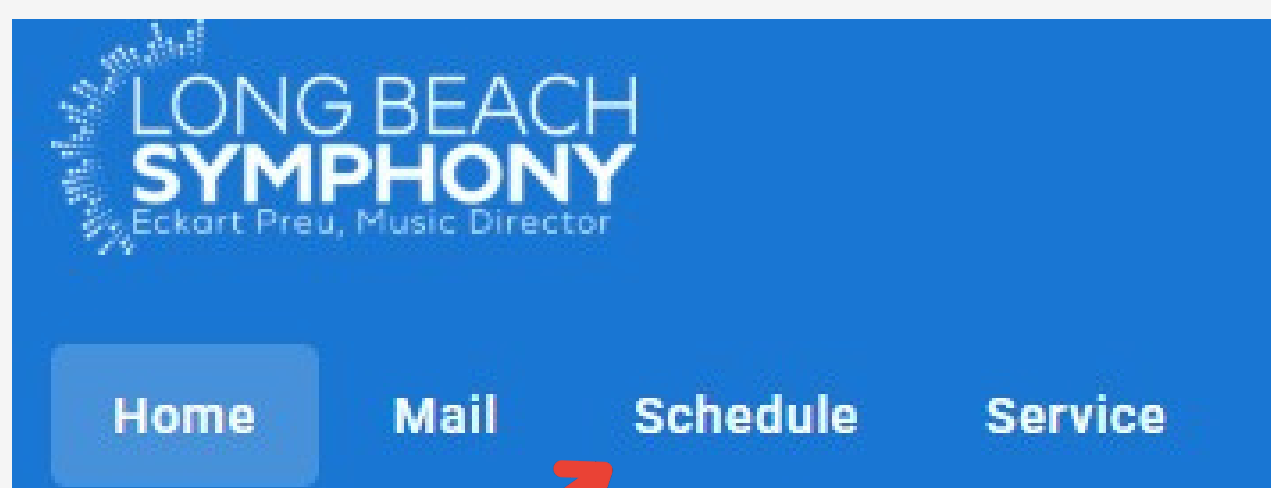
Before using VicNet, volunteers must first complete a **volunteer application form**.
